Risk Management Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this Policy is to provide guidance for the management of risks associated with the clubs sporting activities.

It is the responsibility of all club members and volunteers to identify, respond and communicate risks associated with activities conducted by the club.

Our Commitment

Perth Pirates Dragon Boat Club (PPDBC) is committed to providing a safe environment that enables all participants to complete activities safely.

PPDBC will take all reasonably practicable measures to eliminate or minimize risks to health, safety and welfare of club members, volunteers and club visitors who participate in our training and sporting events and anyone else who may be affected.

PPDBC will endeavor to:

Provide a mechanism through which club concerns, risks and hazards can be identified and the necessary steps implemented to address the issues.

Implement an incident process to clearly identify the corrective actions required to prevent a recurrence of the incident.

If it is not reasonably practicable to eliminate the hazard, the risk will be reduced to "As Low As Reasonably Practical" (ALARP) within the clubs control and authority.

Comply with relevant legislation, applicable codes of practice and Dragon Boating WA requirements and conditions.
