Health and Safety Policy

Perth Pirates Dragon Boat Club (PPDBC) is firmly committed to a policy enabling all sporting activities to be carried out safely, and with all possible measures taken to remove (or at least reduce to As Low As Reasonably Practical) risks to the health, safety and welfare of club members, volunteers, club visitors, and anyone else who may be affected by our activities.

We are committed to ensuring we comply with Work Health and Safety legislation, regulations, applicable Codes of Practice, Australian Dragon Boating Federation and Dragon Boating WA requirements.

PPDBC will strive to continually improve our systems and processes. This will be done by monitoring activities and implementing changes and control measures to create a safe environment.

In support of this policy, the club accepts its responsibility for the prevention of accidents through identification, assessment and elimination of hazards where reasonably practicable and within the clubs control and authority.

Club members will be consulted and encouraged to participate in matters which affect their health and safety and in observing and recommending changes to reduce exposure to any hazards and risks.

PPDBC expect all its club members to accept responsibility for their actions, to report unsafe acts and conditions, to actively participate in improvement processes and behave in a manner that reflects safe practices and standards.

This policy will be reviewed on an annual basis and when legislative change occurs.
